What is the difference between biodynamic and organic wine?

Commercial wine companies pump mass amounts of preservatives, caseins, and dyes to help prolong the shelf life of wine and produce products in mass volumes.

Commercial wine uses fillers to expand their products, these fillers have been traced to ingredients such as fish guts. ew!

Real wine continues to ferment, and can only stay for a day or a few after opening and refrigerating. Commercial wines can stay longer, but always reach a toxic level of fermentation after opening and sitting in the fridge for a few days.

Buy Local! -cuts out preservatives and additives. More sustainable brands and products are even made in families' homes.
